
**DISTRICT CLEANING STANDARDS PROCEDURE FOR LOCKER

1.0 SCOPE:

- 1.1 This procedure describes the recommended custodial cleaning standards for locker rooms.

2.0 RESPONSIBILITY:

- 2.1 All custodial staff

3.0 APPROVAL AUTHORITY:

- 3.1 Assistant Director of Maintenance and Operations

4.0 DEFINITIONS:

- 4.1 Power scrub - use the automatic scrubber, with red pad, to deep clean floor

5.0 PROCEDURE:

- 5.1 Empty all trash—daily.
- 5.2 Sweep all floors and shower area—daily.
- 5.3 Mop or power scrub floors and shower areas with disinfectant cleaner—daily.
- 5.4 Clean all bench areas with disinfectant cleaner—daily.
- 5.5 Clean all restroom areas per restroom cleaning standards (MNO-P015)—daily.
- 5.6 Mop out shower area with bleach and water solution—weekly.
- 5.7 Clean shower walls with disinfectant cleaner—monthly.
- 5.8 Clean locker tops—weekly.
- 5.9 Replace burned out lights—weekly.
- 5.10 Check and replace exit sign lights—weekly.
- 5.11 Check emergency lights—monthly.
