POSITION:	Color Guard Advisor Wenatchee High School Stipend: \$2,425 –\$3,118
QUALIFICATIONS:	Previous experience teaching, supervising or participating with a Colorguard Team at the high school level preferred. Good human relations skills and ability to work as a team player. Current Wenatchee High School employee preferred. Certificated personnel and/or at least 21 years of age preferred.
RESPONSIBILITIES:	Responsible for planning and coordinating rehearsals and performances throughout the school year. Attend rehearsals, performances and activities for the guard. Design and teach routines for field show and parades with the possibility of winterguard. Work with band director as appropriate. Assist in preparing yearly budget, including coordinating fund raisers. Meet with parents and booster group. Join appropriate associations and organizations (winterguard international, etc.). Assist in the preparation of student athletes for performances and at the same time, receive instruction that will lead to the formulation of good citizenship, pride of accomplishment, self-discipline and self-confidence.
