**Wenatchee School District No. 246****PROCEDURES FOR ORCHARD SPRAY DRIFT ON SCHOOL GROUNDS, EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES**

The school principal and, when needed, the district's maintenance supervisor, will contact growers whose property is adjacent to said school grounds, equipment and facilities, in order to develop agreed upon communication protocols when growers will be making spray applications. The communication should be done with as much advance notification as possible.

School administrators will notify Wenatchee Schools' Maintenance Department that will:

1. Power wash all playground equipment that might be exposed to spray drift.
2. Mow the field.
3. Irrigate the field.

Following the maintenance procedures, the school will:

1. Place orange cones or flags on the part of the playground and/or field which will be restricted for student access. The playgrounds and/or fields shall remain posted for the remainder of the school day or until re-entry is considered to be safe.
2. Modify recess to include, but is not limited to, conducting recess inside or limiting activities to the black top.
3. Keep all students off of the playfields for the remainder of the school day.
4. School staff will continue to stress the importance of students washing their hands when they return to the classroom from the playground.

School district administrators will keep record of communications with growers and document implementation of the maintenance procedures described above.
