

## FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

**REVENUES FROM DISCRETIONARY LOCAL TAXES**

In the fall of each year, the district shall consider the necessity of requesting voter approval of an excess property tax to be collected in the year following voter approval. Such a levy, if any, shall be in that amount permitted by law, which the board determines necessary to provide educational services beyond those provided by state appropriations. The board shall solicit advice from staff and patrons prior to establishing the amount and purposes of the special levy request. Each year the special levy being collected that year shall be presented by program and expenditure in the district's annual descriptive guide for patrons as required by law.
