<b>Code</b>	<b>Short Description</b>	<b>Long Description</b>
<b>I</b>	American Indian or Alaska Native	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America), and who maintains tribal affiliation or community attachment.
<b>A</b>	Asian	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.
<b>B</b>	Black or African American	A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
<b>H</b>	Hispanic or Latino	A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.
<b>W</b>	Caucasian or White	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.
<b>P</b>	Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.
<b>M</b>	Of more than one race or Multiracial	A person of multiple race categories.
<b>X</b>	Not Provided	A person who has chosen not to provide information
