Arts Time Conference: Update

Arts Time will be held in Tukwila on March 23rd and 24th. There will be five subs provided by Human Resources so that five certificated teachers may attend Arts Time. **(Lisa made a mistake in her email yesterday. 5 subs not 7)** Music teachers Tami Lopushinsky, Cheryl Martinez, and Theresa Ogan will be using three of those subs.

CBPAs: Update

The elementary music teachers will each administer music CBPAs before March 15, 2007. They will score their tests and bring examples of a 4, 3, 2, and 1 test to an elementary music meeting scheduled for a later date. There was little information on what the plans are for middle school and high school. Don Collins said that he was doing a CBPA the week of January 23. Jonette has been giving CBPAs for fifth grade to her eighth grade students to get them ready for the eighth grade CBPA in visual art. Jodi Smith would like us to bring examples of fours, threes, twos and ones for our respective CBPAs to the next arts articulation meeting so that we may have discussions about scoring. That meeting is scheduled for March 13 at 3:30 p.m.

Arts Specialist: Update

Schedule:

Kindergarten will most likely be included on the schedule. Principals were adamant about this happening. Lisa has worked out some proposed schedules which show kinders having art once a week for thirty minutes and grades 1-5 will have art once every other week for a full hour. This schedule will allow additional prep time to the elementary teachers and came about through negotiations. **Cabinet will take suggestions from principals and finalize total minutes end of February/ beginning of March.**

Curriculum:

Lisa Pattison has been working on an elementary art curriculum. However, she has a good lead on a curriculum already designed for elementary developed by a lady in Oak Harbor. Lisa will be contacting her.

Hiring:

There will be 3.5 FTE certificated art teachers hired to cover the elementary schools. Lisa will be attending job fairs in Seattle and Spokane although there seem to be a number of certificated art teachers right in the Wenatchee area. The application is posted on the Wenatchee School District web site. Principals and Wenatchee art School District art teachers will be on the interview team.

Vertical Teaming:
