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GUIDE TO UNDERSTANDING THE WENATCHEE DISTRICT ELEMENTARY REPORT CARD

The Elementary Report Card has been revised to reflect the improvements in the elementary curriculum and instructional standards. The standards are clear expectations for what all students should know and be able to do. The scores indicated for your child in each of the academic learning areas reflect your child's progress toward meeting the learning standards for this grade level. To make this determination, your child's teacher systematically gathers information from a variety of sources in the classroom on a daily basis. This includes teacher observation, teacher-student discussions, paper-and-pencil tests, and performance on tasks assigned by the teacher.

There are four performance levels for each academic area. Definitions of these levels are given below.

- LEVEL 4 ABOVE STANDARD
This level represents superior performance, notably above that required for meeting the standard at this grade.
- LEVEL 3 MEETS STANDARD
This level presents solid academic performance for this grade. Students reaching this level have demonstrated proficiency over challenging content.
- LEVEL 2 WORKING TOWARD STANDARD
This level denotes partial accomplishment of the knowledge and skills that are fundamental for meeting the grade level standards.
- LEVEL 1 BELOW STANDARD
This level denotes little or no demonstration of the prerequisite knowledge and skills that are fundamental for meeting the standards at this grade.
